An hour's walk along the beach, led by a local naturalist guide, brings you to a forest trail up the Rio Pargo. Enormous primary growth trees dripping with epiphytic plants, such as orchids, bromeliads and ferns are numerous in this area. The quiet of the jungle is occasionally broken with the guttural bark of howler monkeys, the shrieks of scarlet macaws and the rustle of agoutis in the bush. Sloths make their slow way among branches overhead. The rainforest canopy creates a cool environment for hiking well-groomed trails.

A midday we'll have lunch under the shade of a mango tree on Llorona beach allows you to enjoy the hiss and boom of the surf while resting from your morning's expedition. The next leg of the adventure is a walk up the San Pedrillo River, leading to a rainforest waterfall great for a cool dip. Keep your eyes open for exotic birds and small wildlife. Kingfishers and Jesus Christ lizards are residents of this river. The park is home to cougars, jaguars, ocelots, and giant anteaters, all endangered species. Four species of monkey live in the trees overhead: the howler, white-faced capuchin, spider and squirrel monkey. The park also protects the largest population of scarlet macaws in Costa Rica. As macaws mate for life, they usually fly in pairs. You'll see their brilliant colors displayed against the green of the forest.

In late afternoon, with senses heightened, we board the return craft to the lodge

There are several trails inside the island that lead to the Indian burial sites. Here you can contemplate the perfectly store spheres that they used to adorn their sacred sites. It is still a mystery to the scientific community how these spheres were made.

The diving and snorkeling crowd will be treated to an underwater playground of caves, cliffs and canyons at seven separate dive sites. White-tipped shark, barracuda, red snapper, dog-toothed snapper, and several varieties of rays are a few of the marine species awaiting you. Snorkelers will enjoy schools of colorful tropical fish closer to shore. Cano Island is surrounded by five platforms of low reefs where over a dozen species of coral grow abundantly. These shelves house countless life forms like sea urchins, lobsters, and all sorts of giant conchs.

After a picnic lunch shaded by almond trees on the beach, guests are free to explore the island's burial sites on self-guided trails, play a friendly game of beach volleyball, go for another round of swimming, snorkeling, diving, or simply relaxes on the sun-warmed sand. The

It is wet, remote and rugged, but the trails are relatively good.

The site was occupied ca. 700 to 850 d. C., where there was a city founded by Dos Pilas, and the last capital of the state of Petexbatún, is located in the southwest of Petén, Guatemala, at the southern tip of the Petexbatún lagoon, on a 90 m high cliff, which gave the city excellent defensive position and view of the area, in addition to being protected in front by a wall 3 m high. The main square is separated from the rest by a natural fault of 3 m wide and about 5 m deep.

The city was abandoned in a hurry, and never rehabited, which gave archaeologists the rare opportunity to find many everyday and ceremonial objects in excellent condition, hidden in diverse structures. Among its structures and monuments, the site has eight stelae, three squares, two palaces and several temples and also has a small museum.

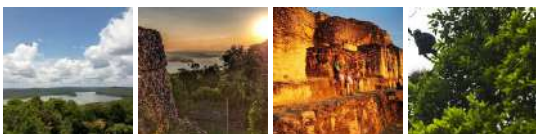
Yaxhá is an ancient Maya archaeological site located in the Petén region of northern Guatemala. It is situated within the Yaxhá-Nakum-Naranjo National Park, near the shores of the Yaxhá Lagoon. Yaxhá was one of the largest cities in the Maya world during the Classic period (c. 250-900 AD) and played a significant role in Maya civilization.

The site contains the remains of more than 500 structures, including pyramids, temples, palaces, ball courts, and residential complexes. The most prominent structures include Temple 216, Structure 216, and Structure 216-2. The Temple of the Red Hands is another notable feature, named for the red handprints found on its interior walls.

One of the distinctive features of Yaxhá is its scenic location, surrounded by dense tropical forest and overlooking the lagoons and wetlands of the Yaxhá Basin. Visitors to the site can climb many of the structures, offering panoramic views of the surrounding landscape.

Yaxhá was an important political and economic center in the Maya lowlands, with evidence of long-distance trade networks and interactions with other major Maya cities such as Tikal and Calakmul. The site was inhabited for over a thousand years before being abandoned around the end of the Classic period, likely due to a combination of environmental factors and political unrest.

Today, Yaxhá is a popular tourist destination and a UNESCO World Heritage site, attracting visitors interested in exploring Maya history and culture amidst the beauty of the Guatemalan jungle.

Tikal is one of the most fascinating and awe-inspiring of Guatemala's ancient Mayan cities. Hidden deep in the lush rainforests of northern Guatemala, a visit to these remarkable ruins in Flores is not to be missed on your itinerary!

The national park (UNESCO World Heritage Site) of Tikal is a protected area about 576 square kilometers, on the edge of the large "Reservado la Biósfera Maya". Dating back to around 400 BC, Tikal was a powerhouse during the classic Mayan period, then gradually succumbed to a ruinous state in the midst of the jungle, until it was unearthed and excavated in the 20th century. Rising out of the dense jungle, the looming temples demonstrate the mighty civilization of the ancient Mayans.

Animal species that can be found include the howler and spider monkeys and toucans and parakeets. Exploring Tikal will help you discover the Mayan spiritual and universe vision. The overwhelming harmony hides one of the most important and majestic cities from Mayan Time.

Your tour guide is with you the whole way to fill you in on the history of the area and answer questions. The guide will also cover the bio-diversity of Tikal. You'll hear the howler monkeys echoing off the temples and the spider monkeys swinging tree to tree. Tikal is host to toucans, coatimundi and a million other creatures great and small. Ruins will rise before you as they did in the days of antiquity like a stairway to heaven, as you follow in the footsteps of the ancients.



Transportation From Tikal To Uaxactún

Located 30 minutes from Tikal is the Astronomical Site of Uaxatún, an incredible and important place for the Mayan civilization.



Uaxactún

The archeological site of Uaxactún is located 23km north of Tikal.

Beyond the archeological site around the Maya city, a marvelous community is found, which has survived

time and limited conditions of living among the jungle. We will learn about dolls made from cornhusks decorated with beads and dried flowers, very peculiar and famous on the region. But the principal source of income is the "Xaté Palm", the long-lasting leaves give the plant a huge market, used in flower arrangements, decoration and specially during Easter. This tiny community is in charge of the cultivation and export packaging, so they have been placed as one of the largest producers of this product.

In its history, Uaxactún was the main producer of CHICLE (natural chewing gum) from tree aloe. This product was exported in ships to various continents including Europe, until artificial chewing gum creation.

This archeological site has one of the most relevant astronomical observatories of the classical period, due to its different occupations we can distinguish the political relevance of Uaxactún by having a presence since preclassic period.

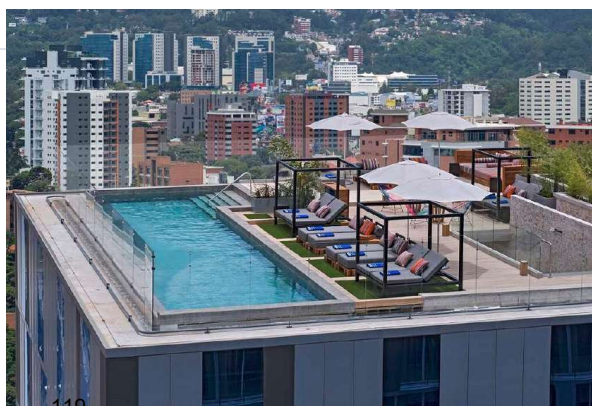

Visit Chichicastenango Mayan Market

Private

Chichicastenango (local refers to it as Chichi) is an indigenous town in the Guatemalan highlands and is home to one of the largest markets in Central America, which was established before the Spanish arrival. Its primary purpose is to service locals who come far and wide to buy and sell products. On a visit here, you'll browse the market, whose vendors sell everything from handicrafts and textiles to fresh produce and street food. You'll even get to visit an artisanal mask factory

You also won't want to miss the nearby Iglesia de Santo Tomás. This 16th-century Roman Catholic church is built on the site of a former Maya temple and is a striking example of Guatemalan syncretism (a mix of ancient Maya religious beliefs and traditional Catholicism). Besides sightseeing and sampling typical foods like Guatemalan bananas and *pan de muerto* ("bread of the dead"), you'll also browse a local textile factory to see the process of making the traditional outfits of the region. Following this is a traditional dance performance, and then you'll return to your hotel.

Note: the market is open on Thursdays and Sundays.



Chichicastenango Mayan Market takes place every Thursday and Sunday, will make you appreciate a vibrant glimpse into Maya culture.

San Juan La Laguna is a tiny village (pueblito), home to cooperatives that produce traditional textiles, paintings, and weavings. Everything is handmade, conserving multiple techniques from the past; this is one of the reasons why it's easy to fall in love with this lesser-visited village around Lake Atitlán. San Juan La Laguna also produces cotton and uses the Artisanal Maya process of yarn dyeing with natural ingredients.

You'll visit an apiary and a painting workshop. Beyond all these little details, San Juan la Laguna offers a peaceful atmosphere that embraces you and makes you want to stay forever.

The town of **Santiago Atitlán** is where the syncretized deity **Maximón** is currently residing (check when you visit as it does move every year). Santiago Atitlán is home to the **Cojolya Weaving Center and Museum**, founded by the Cojolya Association of Maya Women Weavers. The museum shows the history, tradition, and process of backstrap-loom weaving and the evolution of the traditional costume of the Tz'utujil and the indigenous people of Santiago Atitlán.

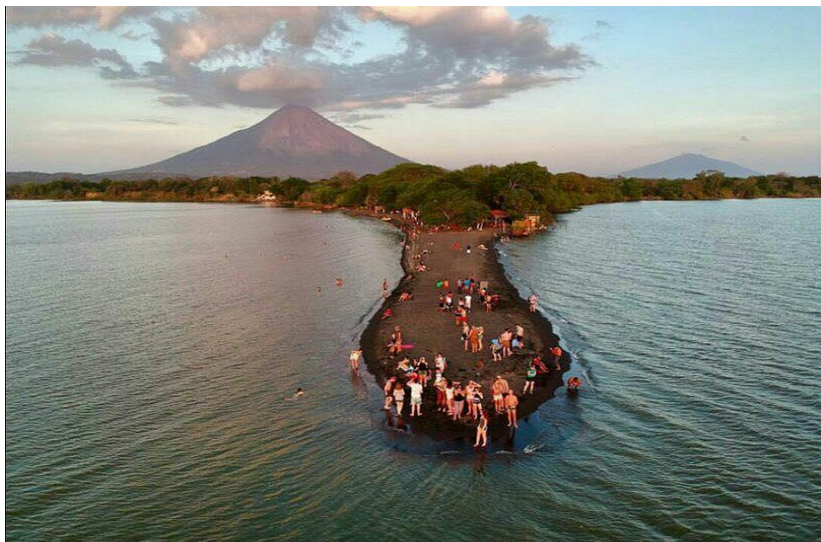

Day 03 / Ometepe Island

08:00 Hrs. Our staff Pick you up at your hotel in San Juan del Sur.

Private guided transfer from Morgans Rock to San Jorge Port. Once you arrive to Ometepe Island you will do a stop at Jesus Maria Lookout.



Punta Jesús María is the westernmost point on Ometepe Island. When you arrive at this point you can see a very narrow strait of land that extends into Lake Nicaragua, which can be up to a kilometer long in dry times. You can walk on this stretch of sand, with water splashing on you from both sides. However, during the rainy season, the water level can rise so much that it causes this

strait to disappear.

Despite this, Punta Jesús María is equally interesting in the rainy season. During this time of year, even though the strait is covered by water, you can still observe an interesting phenomenon. The waves come from both sides, left and right, and crash into each other right in the middle of this point. It's the same thing that happens when two seas meet, but on a smaller scale.

Then you will continue to Charco Verde.

The natural reserve Charco Verde is a protected area located between the two volcanoes of Ometepe, at the bottom part of the island. The area encompasses a lagoon, forest, and a beach. The lagoon is called Laguna Verde (Green Lagoon) and it is closed off from the lake by only a thin strip of land. The lagoon provides a shelter place for many birds.



The beach of Charco Verde is one of the best beaches on Ometepe. The quiet and rather private beach called Bancon is perfect for swimming and relaxing. You can hike through the



forest to this beach and back to the entrance of the reserve, which will take around one hour if you do not stop at the beach. During the hike you can enjoy the nature and you can also observe the main land which is visible on the horizon from this side of the island. Then you will continue to the springs water pools Ojo de Agua, where you can take your lunch and swim.

of tropical colors and historic mansions converted into beautiful boutique hotels and fine restaurants. Once you finish the city tour, you will continue to Islets boat trip.



When the Mombacho volcano erupted many years ago, it spewed huge boulders into Lake Nicaragua. As a result of this violent eruption, 365 small islands were formed off Granada. The islands vary in size and shape from a hundred square metres to over a hundred hectares. Nature, local and migratory birds, and the daily life of native families

make it an ideal place for boating and kayaking.

These islands, called Las Isletas in Nicaragua, serve different purposes. The islands are home to a community of about 1200 people, mostly fishermen. Other islands are home to hotels or luxury houses (some can be rented). There are also uninhabited islands where only palm trees grow.

You will stop at The Fortress San Pablo where you can stay for 10 to 20 minutes.

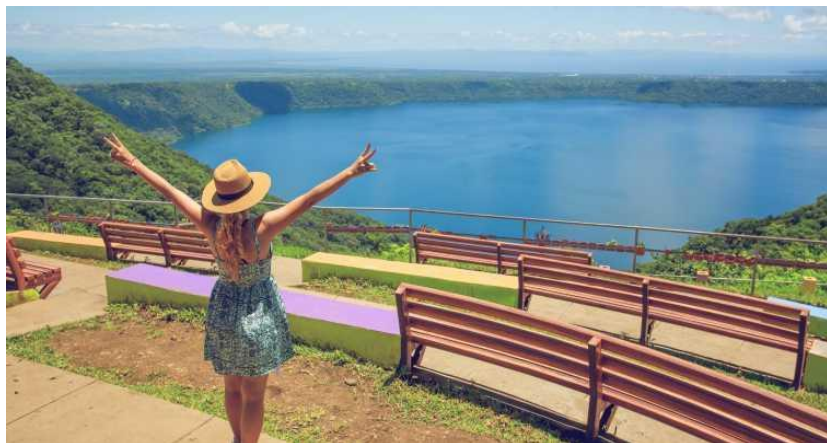
This dormant volcano has four craters. All craters are covered with cloud forest. On the Mombacho volcano you can go on different hikes. You can observe fumaroles, find a great variety of trees and plants that thrive due to the humidity of the forest, you can also observe howler and white-faced monkeys, as well as snakes, deer, reptiles, birds and insects and sloths. On clear days you will have nice views of the colonial city of Granada, Lake Cocibolca, Las isletas and La Laguna de Apoyo.

It is 1.5 km long and takes you to the dwarf forest and fumaroles with a spectacular view to the north where you can see Granada, the islets, Apoyo Lagoon and the Masaya Volcano National Park. It is self-guided and takes about an hour and a half. It goes from 900 to 1150 meters above sea level.

Then you will continue to San Juan de Oriente.

What distinguishes this municipality are its various craft workshops, in which there is an active and diverse production of attractive clay and ceramic pieces. Throughout the urban area of the town of San Juan de Oriente you can find workshops and some stores, offering decorative or utilitarian crafts, in bright colors or sober tones. Later you will continue to Catarina.

The Mirador de Catarina is the highest point in the urban area of the town, which allows it to have a pleasant climate. The view is **WONDERFUL**, you can see the crater of Laguna de Apoyo, the Mombacho Volcano, Isletas de Granada and Lake Nicaragua. At the Mirador de Catarina, you can take walks, shop for crafts, horseback riding, enjoy live music offered by trios and marimbas, taste dishes of the national cuisine.





Later you will continue to Handicraft market.

The Mercado Artesanal de Masaya, also known as Mercado Viejo, Nicaragua's most famous market and a major tourist attraction. The whole block is a hive of stalls where you'll find the highest quality handicrafts in the country.

After your day of adventure around the lagoon you will return to Granada to enjoy a nice evening meal.
