# Reykjavík


<u>Day 1:</u> Arrival at Keflavik International Airport. Private transfer to Reykjavik. Private panoramic tour of the capital city, with our guide in English, where you will get to see the main monuments and buildings of the city. Night in a central hotel in Reykjavík.

#### Golden Circle

<u>Day 2:</u> On this first day you will discover this popular region of Iceland, rich in history, powerful waterfalls and geothermal pools, erupting geysers, divergence of tectonic plates...Night in Hella.







### South coast of the Island

<u>Day 3:</u> You will head towards road number 1 on the south coast of the island, with a first stop at the Lava Center exhibition, passing the waterfalls of Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss, the small town of Vík, one of the largest lava fields in Iceland: Eldraun. Night around Jökursárlón.





# Vatnajökull glacier

<u>Day 4</u>: The adventure continues to the east of the country through the National park of Skaftafell, and the two incredible glacial lagoons of Fjallsárlón and Jökulsárlón. Excursion to a natural ice cave in Europe biggest glacier: Vatnajökull. Night around Jökulsárlón.


#### Adventure day

<u>Day 5:</u> The day will be spent driving back along the south coast, making stops in some of the most iconic places: Dyrhólaey, the black sand beach of Reynisfjara, where we will feel the force of nature in its purest form. The glacier tongue of Sólheimajökull is where you will go for a private glacier walk<sup>\*</sup>. Night in Hella.

\*The hike requires a moderate level of physical condition where you will go up uneven and slightly sloping terrain, but you do not need to be an experienced person to do this activity. Titulated guide, material included.







# Reykjanes peninsula

<u>Day 6</u>: Return to the capital through the Reykjanes peninsula, known for its geothermal activity: Seltún and Krýsuvík. Stop at the blue lagoon for a relaxing thermal bath (admission included). Overnight in Reykjavik.









Free day

<u>Day</u> 7: Free day for Reykjavík. Possibility of adding excursions from the capital. Night in Reykjavik.

#### Departure

<u>Day 8</u>: Private transfer to Keflavík International Airport and flight back.




# Reykjavík

<u>Day 1:</u> Arrival at Keflavik International Airport. Private transfer to Reykjavík. Private panoramic tour of the Icelandic capital, with your guide in English, where you will see the main monuments and buildings of the city. Night Reykjavík.

#### Snæfellsnes peninsula

<u>Day 2:</u> Our guide will pick you up at your hotel and will leave for the Snæfellsnes peninsula, also called "Iceland in miniature" because many of the iconic places that define the island. Among the most important is Snæfellsjökull glacier, through which Jules Verne entered the center of the earth in his famous novel "Journey to the Center of the Earth". Night in the Reykholt Valley.







# Travelling north

<u>Day 3:</u> Departure from the hotel, we will visit Glaumbær museum, an old Icelandic farm that will make us imagine how they lived back in the days. From there we will continue through Skagafjörður to the small and beautiful town of Siglufjörður where we will end the day. Night around Siglufjörður.



#### Explore the north

<u>Day 4:</u> We will start the day driving through Eyjarfjörður fjord, the deepest in Iceland, towards Akureyri, the capital of the north. After a walk through the streets of the town we will continue towards Goðafoss: the Waterfall of the Gods, one of the most beautiful in the country. Your guide will take you to Lake Mývatn, where you will explore the lake and its surroundings before ending the day at Mývatn Nature Baths, a well-known geothermal bath in the area. Night around Mývatn.

# Tjörnes peninsula

<u>Day 5</u>: You will leave early from the hotel to Húsavík, where we will go on a whale watching tour. After the activity, you will head towards the capital of the Elves, Ásbyrgi, a place protected by Unesco since 1962. After lunch, we continue towards the most powerful waterfall in Europe, the impressive Dettifoss. We continue on our way to Egilsstaðir, where we will spend the night. Overnight in Egilsstaðir.



### Vatnajökull glacier

<u>Day 6</u>: The day begins with the long and beautiful fjords of the east coast of the country. We will pass through small fishing villages, visit a museum, waterfalls, etc. You can see part of the great Vatnajökull glacier, the largest in Europe. To end the day we will stop at the famous and impressive Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon. Night in the Jökulsárlón area.



#### South coast

<u>Day 7:</u> We will travel along the southern Icelandic coast, making stops in some of the most iconic places: Skaftafell National Park, Eldhraun, one of the largest lava fields in the country, the small village of Vík and its surroundings... Overnight in Vík.



#### Glacier adventura

<u>Day 8:</u> You will start the day on the famous black sand beach of Reynisfjara, to continue towards the glacier tongue of Sólheimajökull, where you will go on an unforgettable glacier hike (all material included, beginners included as the guide will adapt the experience to the possibilities of the group). You will also visit the unmissable Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss waterfalls before visiting the Lava Center exhibition. Night in Hella.





#### Golden Cirlce

<u>Day 9:</u> Our guide will take you through the famous stops at this iconic destination: the Golden circle. The golden waterfall or Gullfoss, the famous Geysir with its brother Strokkur and finally the site of the old Icelandic parliament, Þingvellir National Park, before driving to Reykjavík to end the day. Free afternoon in the Icelandic capital. Overnight in Reykjavik.

#### Departure

<u>Day 10:</u> Private transfer to Keflavík airport for your flight back.
