Next, you'll head to the Palace in the Sky, where you can enjoy more panoramic views of Taal Lake.

Should you choose to visit Laguna, you will enjoy a Pagsanjan Falls day tour that comes with a canoe ride and bamboo rafting. Before reaching the falls, you'll be dropped off at the jump-off point on the banks of Pagsanjan River. From there, you will board a canoe, and with your boatman, you will head upstream to reach the cascades. The falls is around 300 feet high, and you can board a bamboo raft that will take you right to the falling water.



Day 4: Arrival in Laoag City, Ilocos Norte + Check-in

Take advantage of the free breakfast at your hotel before checking out. A driver will pick you up from the hotel and bring you to the Ninoy Aquino International Airport in Manila for your flight to Laoag City in Ilocos Norte.

After landing at Laoag International Airport, you will be picked up by your driver and brought to your hotel in Laoag City. After checking in, you are free to explore the hotel or the nearby areas or just relax at the hotel and take advantage of the facilities and amenities.



Day 5: Ilocos Norte Laoag Attractions Day Tour

Fuel up for your day by feasting on the free breakfast from your hotel. You will be picked up from your hotel so you can begin your Ilocos Norte Laoag attractions day tour. You will visit St. Williams Cathedral, which is also known as Laoag Cathedral. It boasts an Italian Renaissance architectural style, which is great for travel photos. Just nearby is the Sinking Bell Tower, which is said to sink to the ground about one inch every year. Your next stop is Aurora Park, a plaza that is famous for its multi-tiered obelisk and a fountain that features a statue of Maiden Pamulinawen.

Next, you'll head to Malacañang of the North, which used to be the holiday residence of former president Ferdinand Marcos. Your last two stops are Paoay Lake and Paoay Church, which is a declared UNESCO

World Heritage Site and a popular stop on any North Luzon tour package.



Day 6: Arrival in Vigan + Vigan Heritage Village Tour

Wake up early for your breakfast and check out at the hotel as you need to be ready to go to Vigan. Your tour guide will pick you up for your Vigan Heritage Village Tour. Your first stop is the beautiful St. Paul's Cathedral, which has been around since the 1800s. Next, you'll visit the Bantay Bell Tower, a structure that has been standing since the 1590s.

You'll also visit the Pagburnayan Pottery Making house, where you will learn how to make your own pottery items from clay. After that, you'll head to the Padre José Burgos National Museum. This building was once the ancestral home of Padre José Burgos, one of the three martyr priests executed by the Spanish in 1872. You'll then explore the Ilocos Museum Regional Complex and the Crisologo Museum. You will be able to see a variety of local memorabilia and collections in both museums.

In Baluarte Resort and Mini Zoo, you will enjoy a bit of sightseeing and getting close to animals before heading to your last stop, Calle Crisologo, a cobblestone street lined with Spanish-era houses.

After your tour, you will head to your hotel in Vigan so you can check in after a full day.



Day 7: Arrival in Baguio, Benguet + Add-on Tour

Have breakfast at your hotel in Vigan before checking out. Your private transfer will pick you up and bring you to your hotel in Baguio City. Along the way, you may enjoy lunch at any restaurant at your own expense.

You are scheduled to arrive in Baguio City after lunch, right in time for check-in at your hotel. After check-in, you are free to tour the city on your own.

Next, you'll head to Mines View Park, where you can see an overlooking view of abandoned gold and copper mines. Camp John Hay is your next stop. This former military base is now a recreational complex. You'll also visit the Philippine Military Academy, where you can see tanks and other military weapons on display. Finally, you'll end your tour with a visit to Good Shepherd, where you can buy delicious local delicacies.



Day 8: Baguio City Cultural Private Half-Day Tour with Transfers

To ensure you have energy throughout the day, fill up on the complimentary breakfast at the hotel. Your tour guide will pick you up in the morning for your Baguio City cultural private day tour.

Day 12: Bohol Pamilacan Island Tour & Dolphin Watching with Lunch, Snorkeling Gear & Transfers from Panglao

Before you finally head to your hotel in Mactan, you'll go on a rolling tour of other notable Cebu attractions like Baluarte, Cuartel, Boljoon Church, and the Carcar Shoe Expo.

After your tour, you will head to El Nido via a land trip. Once you arrive at your hotel, check in and rest, or wander in the area at your own leisure.



Day 19: El Nido Big Lagoon Island Hopping
