Day 1 – Bangkok – Arrival

Arrival at Bangkok Airport. After immigration formalities, clients will meet the representative who will be waiting at:

The guide who will wait for travelers at the airport will be there for up to 2 hours from the time the flight lands. In case of encountering very long queues at immigration or having any kind of setback, please connect to the free Wi-Fi at the airport and notify us via WhatsApp call so we can take it into account and coordinate the pick-up.

Day 2 – Bangkok – Bangkok Tour – MANOHRA Dinner Cruise

Hotel pick up: 07:40-08:00 (tour) // (TBA for dinner) Meals: Breakfast

After breakfast at the hotel, the guide will pick us up at the reception to take us to the Golden Buddha or Wat Traimit in the heart of Chinatown. The Golden Buddha is one of the most important representations of Buddha in Thailand since it is a 5.5 tonne gold statue from the Sukhothai period, which is of incalculable value. Then we will continue to the splendid Royal Palace and the Temple of the Emerald Buddha. It is the same complex where we will start by visiting the Wat Phra Kaew where we will see the Emerald Buddha, made from a unique carved piece of jade. Next, we will go to the Royal Palace, the pride of the Thai people and where the Kings lived until the 19th century. Later, we will visit the "Wat Pho" or Temple of the Reclining Buddha. In addition to the impressive image of Buddha, this temple was the first school of traditional medicine and Thai massage, and is considered the first university in the country.

*It is important to wear long trousers and a shirt with sleeves to enter the Grand Palace.

In the afternoon, we will take a cruise on Bangkok's Chao Phraya River to enjoy dinner on the elegant MANOHRA boat while we cruise quietly along the river (drinks not included). At the end, we will be transferred to the hotel.





Day 3 – Bangkok – Railway Market and Floating Market

Hotel pick up: 06:40-07:00

Meals: Breakfast

After breakfast we will head to the market on the railway line or Talad Rom Huup (80 kms). This is a 100% local market where Thais from that province go daily to do their shopping. Six times a day the shopping is interrupted by the train that runs through the market. If we are lucky and the train is running normally, we will be able to see how the vendors dismantle the market in record time to let the old train pass. Incredible and surreal! Even if the train does not pass, we will be able to explore the market and its great offer of everyday products for the local people. Afterwards we will go to the floating market of Damnoen Saduak (15 kms more), the most famous and touristic market in the country, the image of many travel catalogues. There we will have a boat included in the floating market. We will return to the hotel around 13 noon and we will have the afternoon free.



Day 4 – Bangkok – Tour to Ayutthaya – Flight to Chiang Rai

Hotel pick-up: 07:10-07:30 Meals: Breakfast and lunch

We will depart from Bangkok to the ancient capital of the Kingdom of Siam, Ayutthaya. A city believed to have had a population of one million when the main European cities were much smaller. The main nations of the world at the time sent ambassadors here: Portugal, Spain, England, France, China and India.

We will explore its Historical Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, visiting its four most famous temples: Wat Mahathat, Wat Yai Chai Mongkol, Chai Wattanaram and Wat Pra Sri Sanphet. At Wat Mahathat we will be able to see the famous severed head of a Buddha statue that a tree has made its own and protected with its roots.

All these temples are half-destroyed after the Burmese attack in 1767 AD. which forced the Siamese to abandon the city and move further south, founding the city of Bangkok and the State of Thailand. The ruins are from the 14th to the 18th centuries. They are some of the most photogenic and important in the country.

Pick-up at the airport and transfer to the hotel.





Day 5 – Chiang Rai – Blue Temple – White Temple – Wat Huay Pla Kang – Hot Springs – Chiang Mai

Pick up from the hotel: 09:00

Meals: Breakfast and lunch

In the morning we will visit the Blue Temple or Wat Rong Suea Ten, the new jewel of Chiang Rai. A temple recently completed (in 2016 although it was started in 2005), in which the color blue, the color of Dharma, dominates the space. Inside we will find a large white image of Buddha, something also unusual. We will also visit the white temple or Wat Rong Khun, a temple very different from the rest of the Buddhist temples we can see in Thailand. Its totally groundbreaking design, the strange figures that decorate it and its immaculate white that represents the purity of Buddha, usually arouse the admiration of all who visit it. Its construction began in 1997 and still does not have a clear completion date. To finish the visits of this day we will go to the Wat Huay Pla Kang temple, which stands out for its enormous statue of the Bodhisattva Guan Yin, the Goddess of Mercy. Although it is not actually a statue of Buddha, the place has become popular with the erroneous nickname of "Big Buddha". Be sure to climb to the top level of the huge and extravagant 9-story pagoda next to the giant statue, to enjoy magnificent views over the city of Chiang Rai and its surroundings.

We will continue on our way to Chiang Mai and before arriving, we will stop at a hot spring for about 15 minutes to stretch our legs. If we feel like it, we can soak our legs in its hot water. Arrival at your hotel in Chiang Mai.





Day 6 - Chiang Mai - Doi Inthanon National Park Tour

Pick up from hotel: 08:00-08:30 **Meals:** Breakfast and lunch

We will go to Doi Inthanon National Park, which is Thailand's highest peak at 2,565 meters above sea level. Once inside the park, we will visit the beautiful Wachirathan waterfall, the most famous in the park and in the province. Afterwards, we will go to the top in the van where we will visit the 2 huge modern pagodas that were built in honor of the kings of Thailand. If there is no fog, we will get some nice views of the national park. We will have lunch (included) stopping at a local Hmong market and take a 1.5-2 hours hike (quite flat and suitable for everyone) through the forest passing small waterfalls and rice fields, accompanied by a local guide from a tribal village. We will end up in a Karen village where we can have a coffee grown in that same area before returning to the hotel.



Day 7 – Chiang Mai – Private EcoValley Tour – Luxury Thai Massage at The Oasis Spa

Pick up from hotel: (to be determined) **Meals:** Breakfast and lunch

In the morning we will go to the exclusive ECOVALLEY elephant sanctuary where we will learn about these majestic Asian animals. We will be able to observe them in their natural habitat, prepare food for them and learn about them in the small museum that the sanctuary has. We will have lunch there. **In the afternoon**, we will go to the exclusive THE OASIS SPA to enjoy an authentic Thai luxury massage. At the end, return to the hotel.

Day 8 – Chiang Mai – Flight to Krabi

Pick up from hotel: (to be determined) **Meals:** Breakfast Transfer to Chiang Mai airport. Flight to Krabi. Pick up at the airport and transfer to the hotel.

Day 9 – 10 – Krabi – Days Off

Meals: Breakfast Free days in Krabi.

Next, we will go to the part of the Royal Palace, the pride of the Thais and where the Kings lived until the 19th century. Later we will visit the "Wat Pho" or Temple of the Reclining Buddha, in addition to the impressive image of the Buddha, this temple was the first school of traditional medicine and Thai massage, and is considered the first university in the country. We will return to the hotel around 12 - 13 noon and we will have the afternoon free.

*It is important to wear long pants and a sleeved shirt to enter the Grand Palace.

In the evening, we will embark on a romantic cruise (Wonderful Pearl Cruise) on the Chao Phraya River in Bangkok, enjoying a romantic dinner (excluding drinks) while leisurely sailing on the river. When finished, we will be transferred to the hotel.

We will continue to Kanchanaburi (about 100km more) where we will visit the famous Bridge over the River Kwai, the museum and the World War II cemetery. There, thousands of Allied soldiers perished in forced labor under the orders of the Japanese while building the road that was to bring supplies to Burma.



Day 4 – Hellfire Pass – Erawan National Park – Ayutthaya

Meals: Breakfast and lunch

In the morning, we will leave for the Museum of the Hellfire Pass Museum. During World War II, the Japanese imperial army forced allied prisoners of war to build a mountain pass. Hundreds of people and Asian prisoners died while building this passage, known as the Hell's Passage. They say that at night, when work continues to be illuminated by torches, the stage looks like hell. There, we will visit his small museum, take the stairs to the forest, and reach the Hell's Passage (walk 10-15 minutes in the forest).



After that, we will go to the famous Elawan National Park, where we can bathe in the natural swimming pools in the beautiful turquoise waters, which create rivers in the jungle. If we are willing to go further, we can reach Erawan Falls. We suggest you look for some quiet natural swimming pools where you can bathe more intimately. We will continue our journey to Ayutthaya.

*Need to bring a swimsuit, towel and a change of clothes for Erawan comfortable sandals that can be wet are also recommended.

Day 5 – Ayutthaya – Ayutthaya Ruins – Flight to Chiang Rai

Meals: Breakfast and lunch

Visit the ancient capital of the Kingdom of Siam, Ayutthaya. A city believed to have had a million inhabitants when the main European cities were much smaller. The main nations of the world at the time sent ambassadors here: Portugal, Spain, England, France, China and India.

Day 6 – Chiang Rai – Blue Temple – White Temple – Wat Huay Pla Kang – Chiang Mai

Hotel pick up: 09:00 Meals: Breakfast and lunch

In the morning, we will visit the Blue Temple or the new gem Wat Rong Suea Ten in Chiang Rai. A newly built temple (started in 2016 and started in 2005), in which blue, the color of Buddhism, occupies space. Inside, you will find a great white Buddha statue, which is also unusual. We will also visit Wat Rong Khun, a white temple, which is very different from other Buddhist temples we have seen in Thailand. His completely breakthrough design, his strange characters, and the perfect white representing the purity of the Buddha often arouse the admiration of all visitors. Construction began in 1997, and the completion date has not yet been determined. To end the day's tour, we will go to Wat Huay Pla Kang Temple, which is famous for its huge statue of Bodhisatva Guanyin, the pious goddess. Although this is not a real Buddha statue, this place has been wrongly called Big Buddha". Make sure to climb to the top level of the huge and extravagant 9-storey pagoda next to the gigantic statue for magnificent views over Chiang Rai city and its surroundings.

Before arriving in Chiang Mai, we will stop at a hot spring for about 15 minutes to stretch our legs. If we feel like it, we can soak our legs in the hot water. Arrival at your hotel in Chiang Mai.





Day 7 – Chiang Mai – Half day at Kanta Elephant Sanctuary

Hotel pick up: 06:30-07:00 (TBA) Meals: Breakfast

Early in the morning, we will head north from Chiang Mai through mountains, forests and rice fields until we reach the Kanta Elephant Sanctuary (50 minutes). Upon arrival we will dress as mahouts – elephant caretakers – and we will get to know the Asian elephants closely. We will feed them in their natural environment and learn about them. Afterwards we will accompany them to the river for their daily bath and, if we want, we will bathe with them. At the end we will have coffee, tea and fruit before saying goodbye to the elephants and returning to the hotel in Chiang Mai, where we will arrive at around 12 noon. There is no riding in this park.

*This excursion can also be done in the afternoon, but you must notify us at the time of booking. By default it will be in the morning.

The visit was conducted in English and in small groups. It is recommended to wear a bathing suit and change of underwear, sandals, sunscreen and a hat. Of course, bring a camera or mobile phone!



Day 8 – Chiang Mai – Flight to Krabi

Hotel pick up: (to be determined)

Meals: Breakfast

Transfer to Chiang Mai Airport. Flights to Krabi (excluding - we recommend www.airasia. com). Pick up at the airport and transfer to the hotel.

Day 9 – Krabi – Excursion to Koh Phi Phi

Pick up: This tour has a meeting point. NO hotel pick up. The meeting point is the entrance of a resort called KRABI RESORT and customers need to be there at 07:45* **Meals:** Breakfast and Lunch

On this trip, you will enjoy the best spots in Phi Phi (Phi Phi Don, Phi Phi Leh and its lagoon) and in the area, spots whose exact names we cannot reveal to keep them quiet and less known and which will depend on the tides and also on the number of tourists there, since we will try to avoid large groups. We will visit semi-solitary beaches and snorkel in the best spots in the area. We will have



lunch on the sand of one of the beaches we will visit. In addition to lunch, snorkeling equipment, water, fruit and soft drinks will be included.
