Detailed program:

Day 01: Hanoi – Arrival

- ✓ *English speaking guide and private driver*
- ✓ *From the airport to the city center: 30 km ~ 45' by private transport*

Upon arrival at Noi Bai International Airport (Hanoi), you will be perfectly welcomed by our guide and driver, who will take you to the center of Hanoi. The first scenes of the noisy streets of Vietnam will appear before your eyes.



Depending on the arrival time of your flight, you can rest at your hotel if rooms are available or take a city tour on your own:

You will pass through the Old Quarter of Hanoi, also known as “Hanoi and its 36 guilds” and admire the filmy architecture, which preserves many traditional values of Hanoi's former inhabitants such as culture, lifestyle, architecture, craft villages, cuisine, etc. that you have never seen in your country.

Meals on your own and overnight at the hotel in the heart of the capital.

Day 02: Hanoi - Discovery of the capital (B)

- ✓ *English speaking guide and private driver*



After breakfast at the hotel, you will explore the capital city of Hanoi.

You will have 02 options:

Option 01: You will visit Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, where you will find his mausoleum, his house on stilts and his garden inside the presidential palace (In particular, on Mondays and Fridays only the outside of the mausoleum is allowed to be visited due to maintenance of the facilities). Continue to the one-pillar pagoda.

Option 02: You will visit the Vietnam Museum of Ethnology (closed on Mondays). This museum, inaugurated by Jacques Chirac in 1995, represents the traditions, production and recreational activities of Vietnam's 54 ethnic groups. Discover a variety of impressive collections and reconstructions that give

you a complete understanding of the architecture, crafts, music, traditions and traditional dress of this Southeast Asian country. This museum also dedicates a large outdoor exhibition that showcases various genuine traditional housing models of ethnic minorities from all over the country. The success of this museum is mainly due to the cooperation between Vietnamese intellectuals and French specialists in museology. In addition, the building teaches Vietnamese patriotic and revolutionary culture. It is considered a revolutionary relic, a place where various materials, pictures and documents about prominent revolutionaries, as well as evidence of crimes committed by French colonialists are displayed.

You will visit the Temple of Literature, one of the symbols of Vietnamese feudal education. This site pays homage to intellectual curiosity, an important tradition in Vietnamese culture.

Then, you will contemplate the relics scattered around Hoan Kiem (Restored Sword) Lake, such as the Turtle Tower and the Temple of Ngoc Son, and learn about the cultural singularities of the old quarter.

Afternoon theater: you will attend the water puppet dance show, an ancient performance art performance of the Red River Delta.

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Hanoi.

Day 03: Hanoi - Ninh Binh - Hoa Lu - Tam Coc - Bich Dong Pagoda (B)

- ✓ *English speaking guide and private driver*
- ✓ *Hanoi - Ninh Binh: 100 km ~ 2h by private transport*

Breakfast at the hotel. Continue along the charming little road to Ninh Binh, the land christened "Ha Long Bay of land".

Transfer to Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam (under the Dinh dynasty 968-980 and the beginning of the previous Le dynasty 980-1009). You will visit the two temples of the kings dating from the 10th century. They still retain all the beauty of the monumental ensemble, you can admire the delicacy of art with wood and stone sculptures made by Vietnamese craftsmen since the seventeenth century.



In the afternoon, you will embark on a sampan for a pleasant ride on the Ngo Dong River. Amidst the rice fields, you will observe the breathtaking scenery of many limestone peaks with tormented shapes covered with lush vegetation. As a result, we call this place Ha Long Land Bay. Next, you will pass by the three beautiful caves (Tam Coc).

Then you will take a nice bike ride and visit the Bich Dong pagoda (the jade pagoda).

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Ninh Binh.

Day 04: Ninh Binh - Ha Long Bay - Cruise (B, L, D)

- ✓ *Ninh Binh - Ha Long: 180 km ~ 4h by private transport*



After breakfast at the hotel, depart for Ha Long Bay through the vast landscapes of the Red River Delta.

Arriving at Ha Long Bay around noon, you will board the cruise ship, enjoy a welcome drink and spend a few minutes listening to an introduction about the safety of the ship and the activities included. You will then settle into your cabin to freely enjoy the first movements of the cruise.

Lunch is served as the ship sails into Bai Tu Long Bay through magnificent scenery of the seventh wonder of the world with thousands of sugar-cake shaped islands and islets.

Next, you will use a small boat to head to Cap La Island, where you will take a scenic kayak tour through breathtaking views of steep limestone peaks over the emerald waters of Bai Tu Long Bay. You will have time to swim and relax on the white sandy beach. Back on the boat, as the cruise continues, you can relax on the sundeck or take pictures while watching the sunset.

Lunch and dinner are served with excellent local dishes and fresh specialties from the sea.

Dinner, free time and overnight on board.

Day 05: Ha Long Bay - Cruise - Hanoi Q Hue (B, L)

Start the day with a Tai Chi class on the sundeck or enjoy the picturesque views of the bay in the morning. Light breakfast on board.

Afterwards, you will have breakfast on board before departing to Hon Co Island to discover Thien Canh Son Cave, one of the jewels of Bai Tu Long Bay. You will have the opportunity to swim on the sandy beach.



Back on board, the trip will continue peacefully through the most beautiful and quiet hidden corners of Bai Tu Long Bay. You will continue to enjoy the surreal scenery that this place has to offer.

Afterwards, you can participate in a Vietnamese cooking demonstration: how to make NEM CUON and taste dishes prepared by yourself.

A light brunch will be served while the boat returns to the pier.

In the afternoon, return to Hanoi through the breathtaking scenery of the vast rice fields of the Red River Delta. You will be in Hanoi in the afternoon, then transfer by private transportation to Noi Bai International Airport (Hanoi) for the flight to Hue. Upon arrival in Hue, driver will pick you up and take you to the hotel.

Dinner on your own and overnight at hotel in Hue.

Day 06: Hue - Discovery (B)

- ✓ *English speaking guide on board and private driver*



Hue was the capital and cultural, political and economic center of Vietnam between 1802 and 1945, one of the country's most turbulent times. The city's historical heritage and intact architecture will provide visitors with many unforgettable emotions.

After breakfast at your hotel, you will visit for the first time the majestic imperial city of Hue, where 13 emperors of the Nguyen dynasty lived between 1802 and 1945. Over the years, the Hue Citadel still retains all the beauty of an original Vietnamese-Chinese architecture. You will visit sumptuous monuments: Ngo Mon Gate (Southern Gate), Thai Hoa Palace (Supreme Harmony), Royal Library (Thai Binh Lau), Imperial Garden (Ngu Uyen), Royal Theatre, etc.

Next, you will transfer to the beautiful Thien Mu (Heavenly Lady) Pagoda perched on the top of the hill overlooking the Huong (Perfume) River.

In the afternoon, you will visit the mausoleum of King Tu Duc, a mausoleum surrounded by tranquility, nature and one of the most beautiful works of royal architecture of the Nguyen dynasty. On your return to the city center, you will stop at the traditional incense craft village to take photos with bunches of incense sticks of various colors.

You will pass through Dong Ba market in the late afternoon, where you will find products that reflect the skill and delicacy of Hue women artisans, such as conical poem hats.

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Hue.

Day 07: Hue - Da Nang - Hoi An - Discovery (B)

- ✓ *Hue - Hoi An: 120 km ~ 3h30' - 4h by private transport*

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Da Nang taking a charming road of Hai Van Pass that offers a magnificent panorama of the city. There is also a stop at the top of the pass for a beautiful view of Lang Co beach, one of the most beautiful peninsulas in Vietnam.

Arriving in Hoi An Old Town around noon, you will then take a stroll through the narrow streets, flanked by beautiful old houses, testimony to a flourishing era of the country's foreign trade several hundred years ago.



In 1999, UNESCO declared Hoi An, formerly known as "Faifo", a World Heritage Site thanks to its architectural and historical values. Coming to this ancient commercial jewel, you will visit Hoi An's famous monuments, such as: the Japanese bridge, Chinese temple, old house and handicraft quarter, etc.

The rest of the day is completely free for your personal discovery of this ancient port city. Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Hoi An.

Day 08: Hoi An - Da Nang Q Ho Chi Minh City (B)

- ✓ *Da Nang - Ho Chi Minh City : 1h15' by plane*



After breakfast at the hotel, you will transfer to Da Nang airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City, the former Saigon. It is one of the largest cities in the country and a modern, futuristic city whose cityscape is characterized by huge skyscrapers and neon lights. Upon arrival in Ho Chi Minh City, our driver and guide will take you to the city center. You will begin your city tour by visiting the Chợ Lớn Chinatown, with the Bình Tây market and the Thiên Hậu pagoda, dedicated to the worship of the Goddess of the Sea.

In the afternoon, you will visit the Reunification Palace, which was the residence of the President of the Republic of Vietnam until April 30, 1975. Meals on your own and overnight at the hotel in the center of Ho Chi Minh City.

You will then enjoy a walk through the colonial buildings, where you can observe the French presence for almost a hundred years in this land. You will explore Saigon through colonial buildings such as: the Saigon Central Post Office and the Municipal Theater (seen from outside).

Lunch on your own and overnight at the hotel in downtown Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 09: Ho Chi Minh City - Ben Tre (Mekong Delta) - Ho Chi Minh City (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. You will head to Ben Tre to explore the Mekong Delta, the largest rice granary in Vietnam. Upon arrival in Ben Tre, you will board a local boat. You will explore the daily activities of the residents on this private boat as it moves along the river.

You will visit the coconut handicraft workshop while crossing the canal and listen to the southern vocal and musical art "Don ca tai tu", an intangible cultural heritage of the world. You will see how people use all parts of the coconut and taste coconut sweets with honey tea.





Navigation will continue on the Cai Son River. You will disembark at Nhon Thanh village, where local families have specialized in making mats from reed. You will be invited to taste fresh tropical fruits. You will continue by bicycle or tuk tuk, a “motorized vehicle”, through coconut groves and fruit and vegetable gardens.

Then, you will take a ten-minute paddle boat ride through a coconut orchard crossing beautiful and romantic landscapes.

Disembark and return to Ho Chi Minh City in the late afternoon.

Lunch on your own and hotel accommodation in Ho Chi Minh City.

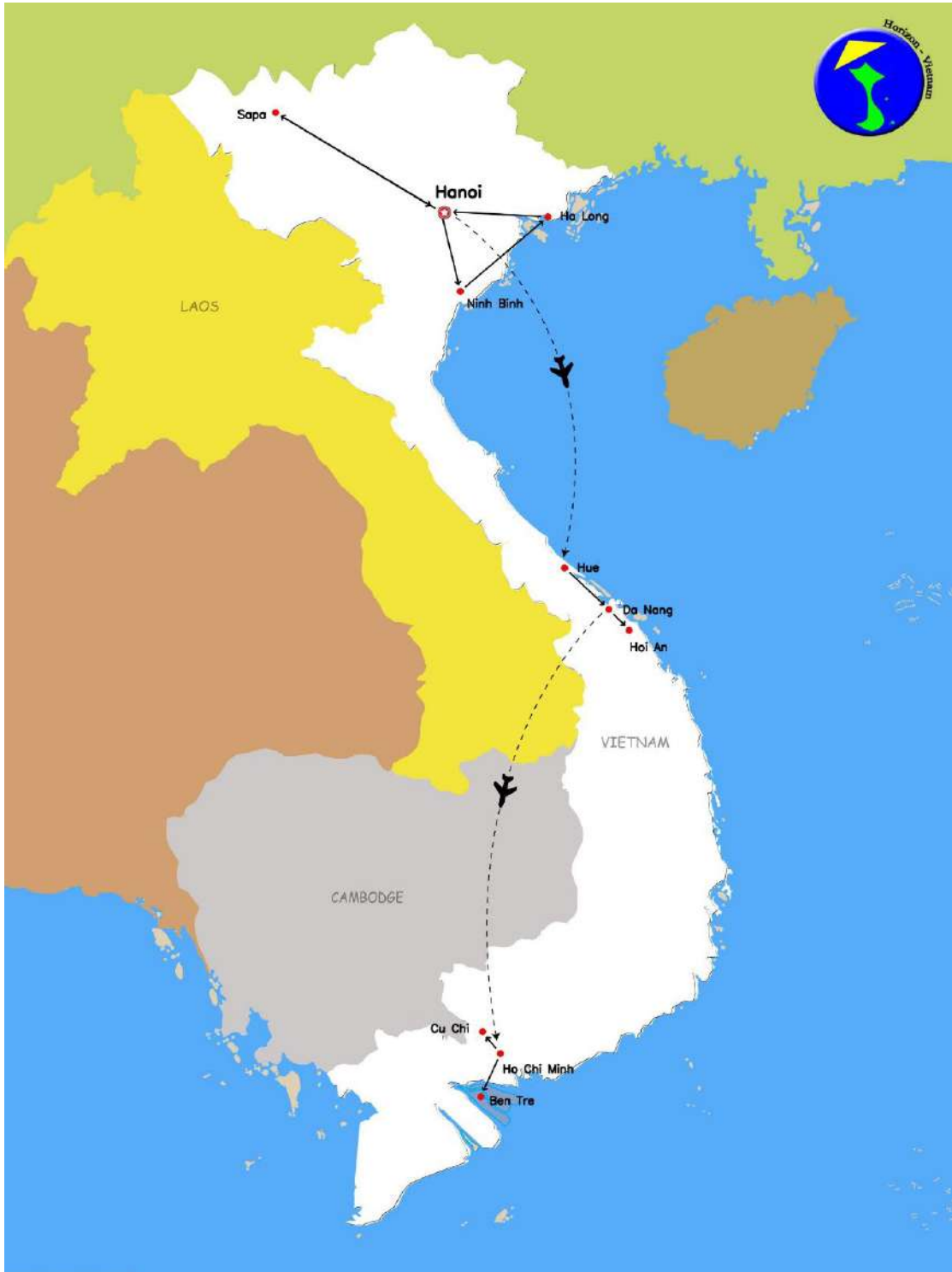

Day 03: Hanoi - Sapa - Thac Bac (Silver Waterfall) - Thac Tinh Yeu (Waterfall of Love) - Sapa (B)

The hotel will prepare breakfast to take away. Departure to Sapa early in the morning. Transfer to the Silver waterfall (thac bac), a unique and beautiful convergence of the northwest mountains. This majestic waterfall over 200 meters high surprised many domestic and international visitors. After ascending the stone stairs, there is nothing better than looking at the white foam of the water, the majestic natural scenery and breathing the fresh air.



Then, you will continue to the beautiful Love waterfall (thac tinh yeu). According to legend, the fairy fell in love with the melodious flute of the woodcutter O Quy Ho.

Unfortunately, their families prevented it. One day, the fairy got angry and turned into a bird to look for her lover, but did not find him. Since then, the top of the pass was christened O Quy Ho. You can contemplate the nearly 100-meter high waterfall meandering like a strip of silk, surrounded by rows of green trees, as you arrive here. At the foot of this waterfall is the Golden Stream, whose water is clear and amber-colored.

Return to Sapa town.

Lunch on your own and overnight at hotel in Sapa.

Day 04: Sapa - Y Linh Ho - Lao Chai - Ta Van - Hanoi (B)

- ✓ *English speaking guide and private driver*
- ✓ *Sapa - Hanoi: 300km ~ 5h by private transport*

❖ *Hike of 6 to 7 km with a duration of 3 hours to 3.5 hours maximum at medium level. Depending on your physical condition and your wishes, we will adapt the duration of the hike to your pace.*

Note: Rice fields are only cultivated in Sapa from July to early September.



Breakfast at the hotel. Then, start the day with an expedition to the beautiful Y Linh Ho valley. The expedition will continue through the Hoang Lien Son mountain range, also known as the "Roof of Indochina". The terraced fields of the Muong Hoa valley provide an opportunity to freely contemplate the beauty of the northwest, which is characterized by fields. Muong Hoa Valley, with many villages and village houses, is beautiful from above. In addition, you will have the opportunity to learn and discover the customs and culture of long-settled ethnic minorities, such as Dao, Tay and H'mong.

Next, you will visit the beautiful ethnic villages of the Lao Chai Valley. The tour will take you through beautiful, wild and romantic landscapes, such as country terraces, hanging bridges and ethnic villages. If you keep walking, you will reach Ta Van. There, you will meet the Black H'mong and Dao people and their way of life and customs.

In the afternoon, you will return to Hanoi. Lunch on your own and hotel accommodation in Hanoi.

Transfer to Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam (under the Dinh dynasty 968-980 and the beginning of the previous Le dynasty 980-1009). You will visit the two temples of the kings dating from the 10th century. They still retain all the beauty of the monumental ensemble, you can admire the delicacy of art with wood and stone sculptures made by Vietnamese craftsmen since the seventeenth century.



In the afternoon, you will embark on a sampan for a pleasant ride on the Ngo Dong River. Amidst the rice fields, you will observe the breathtaking scenery of many limestone peaks with tormented shapes covered with lush vegetation. As a result, we call this place Ha Long Land Bay. Next, you will pass by the three beautiful caves (Tam Coc).

You will discover Mua Cave where you can fully enjoy the beauty of Ninh Binh. To reach the top of Hang Mua, you will have to climb almost 500 rock steps. From the highest point, you can see the beautiful panorama of the area bathed by the Ngo Dong River dotted with karst rock formations and rice fields of different shades of colors.

Discover a variety of impressive collections and reconstructions that give you a complete understanding of the architecture, crafts, music, traditions and traditional dress of this Southeast Asian country. This museum also dedicates a large outdoor exhibition that showcases various genuine traditional housing models of ethnic minorities from all over the country. The success of this museum is mainly due to the cooperation between Vietnamese intellectuals and French specialists in museology. In addition, the building teaches Vietnamese patriotic and revolutionary culture. It is considered a revolutionary relic, a place where various materials, pictures and documents about prominent revolutionaries, as well as evidence of crimes committed by French colonialists are displayed.

You will visit the Temple of Literature, one of the symbols of Vietnamese feudal education. This site pays homage to intellectual curiosity, an important tradition in Vietnamese culture.

Then, you will contemplate the relics scattered around Hoan Kiem (Restored Sword) Lake, such as the Turtle Tower and the Temple of Ngoc Son, and learn about the cultural singularities of the old quarter.

Continue to the suspension bridge over the Cham River to begin your walk in search of water wheels. You will experience how the river water flows through handmade bamboo aqueducts of all sizes and shapes.

You will continue through the valley, among roads and farmland, villages and fields, ponds and rivers, mountains.

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Pu Luong.

Day 11: Pu Luong - Ninh Binh - Hoa Lu - Trang An - Bich Dong Pagoda (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Continue along the charming little road to Ninh Binh, the land christened as "Ha Long Bay of land".

You will visit the two temples of the kings dating from the 10th century. They still retain all the beauty of the monumental ensemble, you can admire the delicacy of art with wood and stone sculptures made by Vietnamese craftsmen since the seventeenth century.

Discover a variety of impressive collections and reconstructions that give you a complete understanding of the architecture, crafts, music, traditions and traditional dress of this Southeast Asian

country. This museum also dedicates a large outdoor exhibition that showcases various genuine traditional housing models of ethnic minorities from all over the country. The success of this museum is mainly due to the cooperation between Vietnamese intellectuals and French specialists in museology. In addition, the building teaches Vietnamese patriotic and revolutionary culture. It is considered a revolutionary relic, a place where various materials, images and documents about prominent revolutionaries, as well as evidence of the crimes committed by French colonialists are displayed.

Next, you will contemplate the relics scattered around Hoan Kiem (Restored Sword) Lake, such as the Turtle Tower and Ngoc Son Temple, and learn about the cultural uniqueness of the old town.

Afternoon theater: you will attend the water puppet dance show, an ancient performance art performance of the Red River Delta.

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Hanoi.

Day 03: Hanoi - Ninh Binh - Hoa Lu - Tam Coc - Bich Dong Pagoda (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Continue along the charming little road to Ninh Binh, the land christened "Ha Long Bay of land".

Transfer to Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam (under the Dinh dynasty 968-980 and the beginning of the previous Le dynasty 980-1009). You will visit the two temples of the kings dating from the 10th century. They still retain all the beauty of the monumental ensemble, you can admire the delicacy of art with wood and stone sculptures made by Vietnamese craftsmen since the seventeenth century.



In the afternoon, you will embark on a sampan for a pleasant ride on the Ngo Dong River. Amidst the rice fields, you will observe the breathtaking scenery of many limestone peaks with tormented shapes covered with lush vegetation. As a result, we call this place Ha Long Land Bay. Next, you will pass by the three beautiful caves (Tam Coc).

Then you will take a nice bike ride and visit the Bich Dong pagoda (the jade pagoda).

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Ninh Binh.

Day 04: Ninh Binh - Ha Long Bay - Cruise (B, L, D)

Lunch and dinner are served with excellent local dishes and fresh specialties from the sea. Dinner, free time and overnight on board.

Day 05: Ha Long Bay - Cruise - Hanoi to Da Nang - Hoi An (B, L)

Day 06: Hoi An - Ecological Tour (B, L)

Breakfast at the hotel, then cycling through the Vietnamese countryside away from the hustle and bustle of the city, traffic and tourist routes.

Return to the local people's house to relax with a herbal foot massage. Afterwards, you will participate in lunch preparation with your family with dishes such as: banh xeo (sizzling pancake), Hoi An spring rolls, Tam Huu (Meat - Shrimp - Herbs with shallot leaves), grilled fish wrapped in guise leaves, etc. Afterwards, you can taste the dishes you have prepared.

You will return to the hotel by electronic car. The rest of the day is completely free for your personal discovery of this ancient port city.

Lunch included, dinner on your own and hotel accommodation in Hoi An.

Day 07: Hoi An - Discovery - Da Nang - Hue (B)

In the afternoon, departure to Hue by taking a charming road of Hai Van Pass which offers a magnificent panorama of the city. Also, stop at the top of the pass for a beautiful view of Lang Co beach, one of the most beautiful peninsulas in Vietnam.

Lunch on your own and hotel accommodation in Hue.

Day 08: Hue - Discovery (B)

Hue was the capital and cultural, political and economic center of Vietnam between 1802 and 1945, one of the country's most turbulent times. The city's historical heritage and intact architecture will provide visitors with many unforgettable emotions.



After breakfast at your hotel, you will visit for the first time the majestic imperial city of Hue, where 13 emperors of the Nguyen dynasty lived between 1802 and 1945.

Over the years, the Hue Citadel still retains all the beauty of an original Vietnamese-Chinese architecture. You will visit sumptuous monuments: Ngo Mon Gate (Southern Gate), Thai Hoa Palace (Supreme Harmony), Royal Library (Thai Binh Lau), Imperial Garden (Ngu Uyen), Royal Theatre, etc.

Next, you will transfer to the beautiful Thien Mu (Heavenly Lady) Pagoda perched on the top of the hill overlooking the Huong (Perfume) River.

In the afternoon, you will visit the mausoleum of King Tu Duc, a mausoleum surrounded by tranquility, nature and one of the most beautiful works of royal architecture of the Nguyen dynasty. On your return to the city center, you will stop at the traditional incense craft village to take photos with bunches of incense sticks of various colors.

You will pass through Dong Ba market in the late afternoon, where you will find products that reflect the skill and finesse of Hue women artisans, such as conical poem hats.

Lunch on your own and overnight at hotel in Hue.

Day 09: Hue ✂ Ho Chi Minh City - Discovery (B)

Breakfast at hotel before transfer to Hue airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh City, formerly Saigon. Upon arrival in Ho Chi Minh City, our driver and guide will take you to the city center.

In the afternoon, you will visit the Reunification Palace, which was the residence of the President of the Republic of Vietnam until April 30, 1975. Meals on your own and overnight at the hotel in the center of Ho Chi Minh City.

You will then enjoy a walk through the colonial buildings, where you can observe the French presence for almost a hundred years in this land. You will explore Saigon through colonial buildings such as: the Saigon Central Post Office and the Municipal Theater (seen from outside).

Lunch on your own and overnight at the hotel in downtown Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 10: Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi Tunnels - Ho Chi Minh City (B)

- ✓ *Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi: 50 km ~ 1h30' by private transport*



After breakfast at the hotel, departure to Cu Chi Tunnels, an unparalleled 250 kilometers long subway passage system with several tunnels including polyclinics, dormitories, meeting rooms, kitchens, warehouses, etc. Visiting this liberated village, you will be immersed in the brave and indomitable spirit of the Vietnamese army and people in their resistance against the Yankees for national liberation.

In the afternoon, return to Ho Chi Minh City via a pleasant country road.

Lunch on your own and hotel accommodation in Ho Chi Minh City.

Día 11: Ciudad Ho Chi Minh - Ben Tre (Mekong Delta) - Can Tho (D)

Breakfast at the hotel. You will head to Ben Tre to explore the Mekong Delta, the largest rice granary in Vietnam. Upon arrival in Ben Tre, you will board a local boat. You will explore the daily activities of the residents on this private boat as you move along the river.

You will visit the coconut handicraft workshop while crossing the canal and listen to the southern vocal and musical art “Don ca tai tu”, an intangible cultural heritage of the world. You will see how people use all parts of the coconut and taste coconut sweets with honey tea.

Navigation will continue on the Cai Son River. You will disembark at Nhon Thanh village, where local families have specialized in making mats from reed. You will be invited to taste fresh tropical fruits. You will continue by bicycle or tuk tuk, a “motorized vehicle”, through coconut groves and fruit and vegetable gardens.



Then, you will take a ten-minute paddle boat ride through a coconut orchard crossing beautiful and romantic landscapes.

Disembark and transfer to Can Tho in the late afternoon.

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Can Tho.

Day 12: Can Tho - Cai Rang floating market - Chau Doc (B)

is the unique summit of the Mekong Delta, where pilgrims come to pay homage to the queen of the country during the first 3 months of the year. You will admire picturesque sunsets overlooking the Mekong Delta.

Day 13: Chau Doc - Phnom Penh (by speedboat) (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, you will visit the monuments of the Grand Circuit, including Pre Rup, 10th century; 10th century Mebon-Hindu Hindu Temple, erected on the central island of East Baray; Ta Som - Buddhist Temple of the late 12th century; Neak Poan (intertwined Nagas) formed by a square basin surrounded by four small basins and Preah Khan (sacred sword) (which was invaded by vines and saplings).

In the afternoon, you will visit Banteay Srei (women's citadel), located on the site of the ancient city of Ísvarapura, 20 km northeast of Angkor, built in the 10th century. in pink sandstone and probably consecrated in 967, during the reign of Jayavarman V and dedicated to Tribhuvanamaheśvara (the Lord of the Three Worlds). After that, you will continue on to Banteay Samre, of elaborate architecture and exceptional carvings. On your way back, you will pass by Srah Srang (ablution pool), where you will contemplate the sunset.

Lunch on your own and overnight at the hotel in Siem Reap.

In the evening, you will enjoy an Apsara dance show while dining at a local restaurant.

Day 17: Siem Reap - Floating village on the Tonlé Sap lake (B)

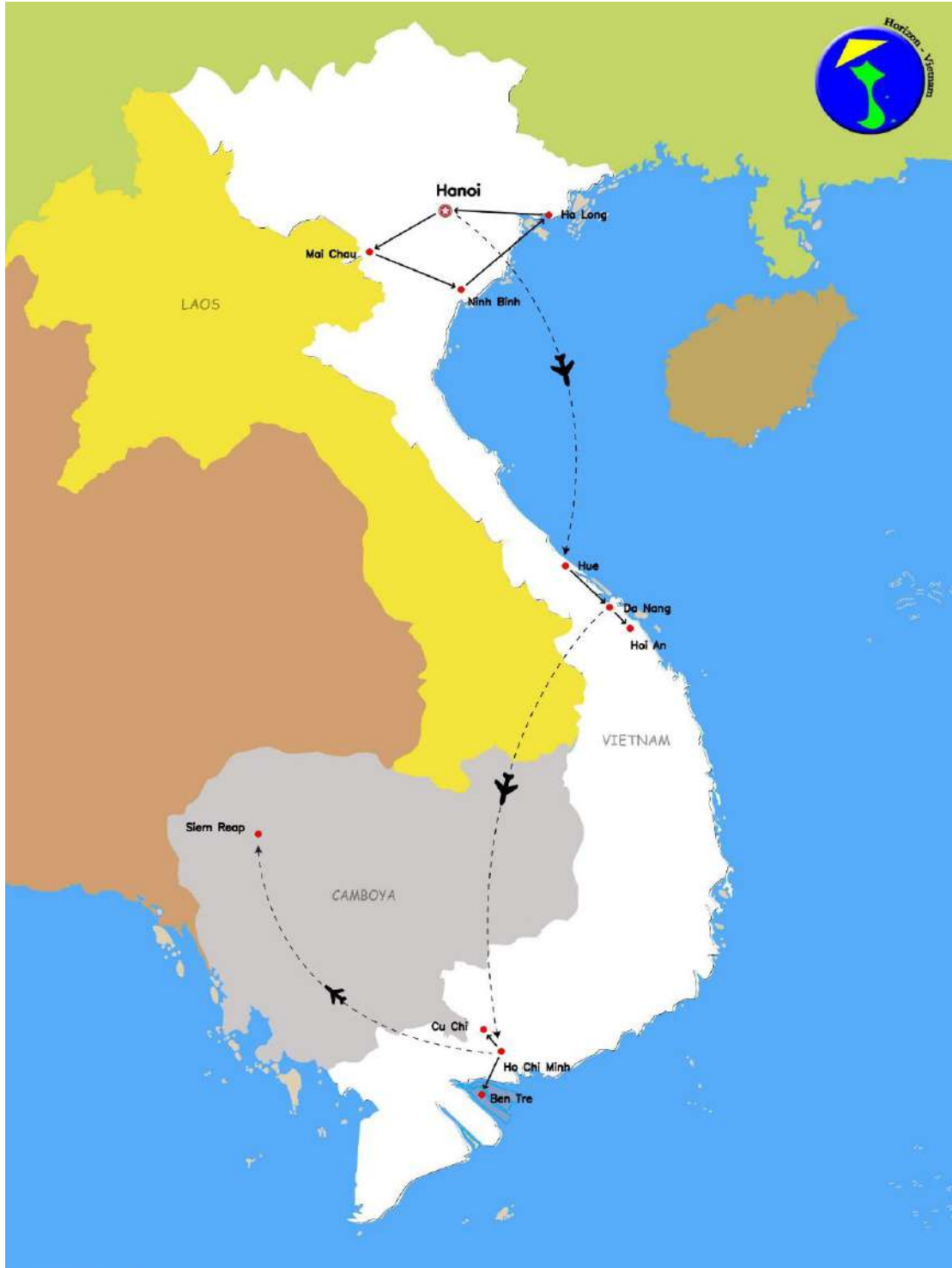

It is considered a revolutionary relic, a place where various materials, pictures and documents about prominent revolutionaries, as well as evidence of crimes committed by French colonialists are displayed.



You will visit the Temple of Literature, one of the symbols of Vietnamese feudal education. This site pays homage to intellectual curiosity, an important tradition in Vietnamese culture.

Then, you will contemplate the relics scattered around Hoan Kiem (Restored Sword) Lake, such as the Turtle Tower and the Temple of Ngoc Son, and learn about the cultural singularities of the old quarter.

Afternoon theater: you will attend the water puppet dance show, an ancient performance art performance of the Red River Delta.

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Hanoi city.

Day 03 : Hanoi - Hoa Binh - Mai Chau (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. 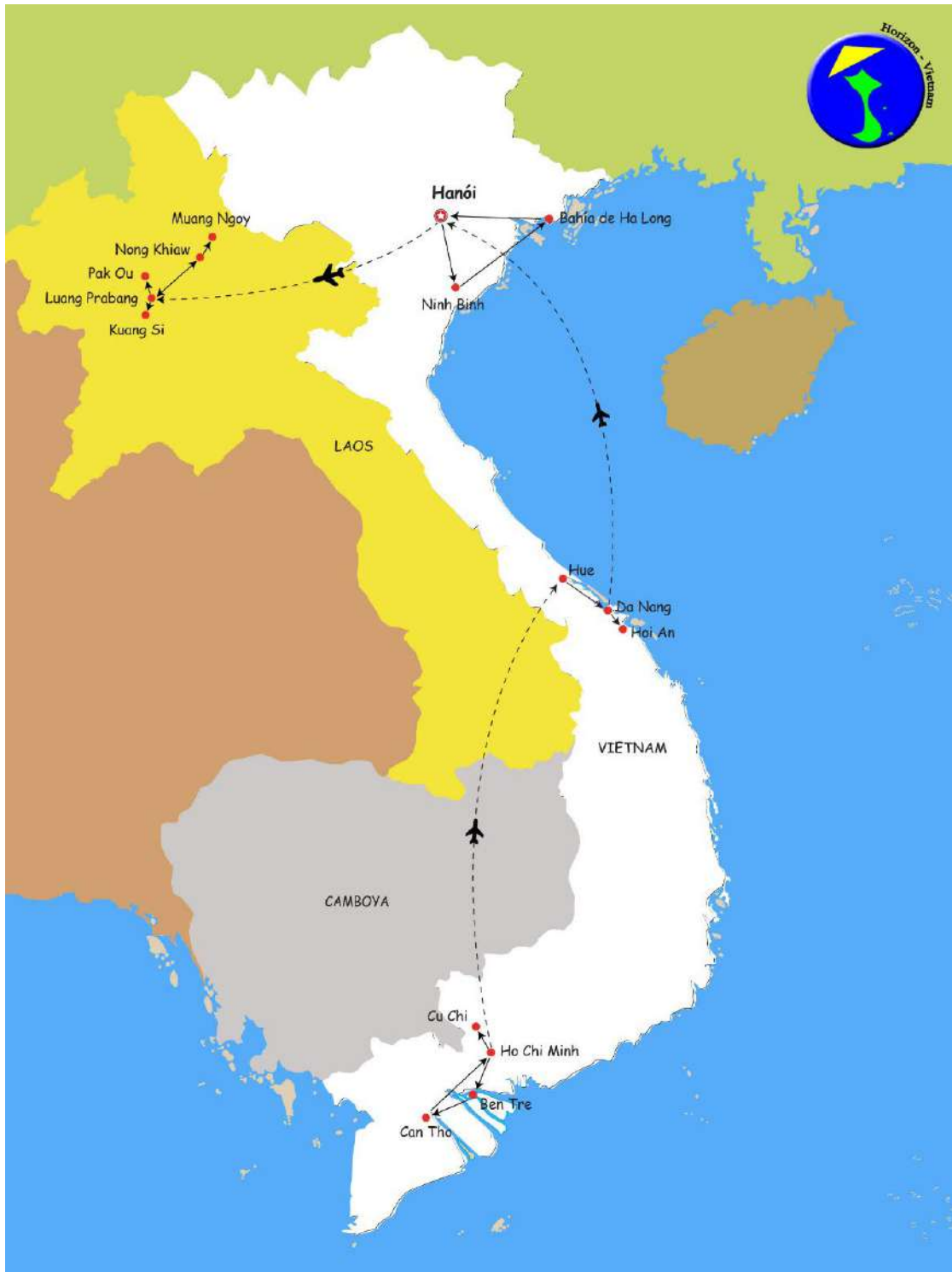

Option 01: You will be amazed by the unprecedented beauty of the 150-meter long golden bridge. It is located more than 1400 meters above sea level and is supported by two giant hands carved in stone. (It is recommended that you go from March to September to make the most of the scenery; the remaining months are usually cloudy or rainy).

Option 02: You will discover the Son Tra (Monkey Mountain) peninsula, once a floating island formed by three mountains. This jewel of Da Nang city has experienced exponential growth in both maritime tourism and spiritual tourism. Among them is the Linh Ung Pagoda, which features the statue of the Buddha of Compassion Kuan Yin (67 meters), the tallest in Vietnam. Next, you will visit the marble mountains of Ngu Hanh Son (Five Elements Mountains) which are prized for their historical, cultural and spiritual values. From the top, you can see the peaceful Ngu Hanh Son Mountain, the majestic Truong Son mountain range and the complex of temples and mysterious caves.

After breakfast at the hotel, departure to the Cu Chi Tunnels, an unparalleled 250 kilometers long subway passage system with several tunnels including polyclinics, dormitories, meeting rooms, kitchens, warehouses, etc.. Visiting this liberated village, you will be immersed in the brave and indomitable spirit of the Vietnamese army and people in their resistance against the Yankees for national liberation.

In the afternoon, return to Ho Chi Minh City via a pleasant country road.

Lunch on your own and hotel accommodation in Ho Chi Minh City.



Day 11: Ho Chi Minh City - Ben Tre (Mekong Delta) - Ho Chi Minh City (B)

- ✓ *Ho Chi Minh City - Ben Tre: 80 km ~ 2h by private transport*



Breakfast at the hotel. You will head to Ben Tre to explore the Mekong Delta, the largest rice granary in Vietnam. Upon arrival in Ben Tre, you will board a local boat. You will explore the daily activities of the residents on this private boat as it moves along the river.

You will visit the coconut handicraft workshop while crossing the canal and listen to the southern vocal and musical art "Don ca tai tu", an intangible cultural heritage of the world. You will see how people use all parts of the coconut and taste coconut sweets with honey tea.

Navigation will continue on the Cai Son River. You will disembark at Nhon Thanh village, where local families have specialized in making mats from reed. You will be invited to taste fresh tropical fruits. You will continue by bicycle or tuk tuk, a "motorized vehicle", through coconut groves and fruit and vegetable gardens.

Then, you will take a ten-minute paddle boat ride through a coconut orchard through beautiful and romantic landscapes.

Disembark and return to Ho Chi Minh City in the late afternoon.

Lunch on your own and overnight at hotel in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 12: Ho Chi Minh City → Siem Reap (B)

Breakfast at hotel and transfer to Tan Son Nhat International Airport for flight to Siem Reap.

Day 13: Siem Reap - Grand Circuit - Banteay Srei - Banteay Samre - Srah Srang (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, you will visit the monuments of the Grand Circuit, including Pre Rup, 10th century; 10th century Mebon-Hindu Hindu Temple, erected on the central island of East Baray; Ta Som - Buddhist Temple of the late 12th century; Neak Poan (intertwined Nagas) formed by a square basin surrounded by four small basins and Preah Khan (sacred sword) (which was invaded by vines and saplings).



In the afternoon, you will visit Banteay Srei (women's citadel), located on the site of the ancient city of Ísvarapura, 20 km northeast of Angkor, built in the 10th century. in pink sandstone and probably consecrated in 967, during the reign of Jayavarman V and dedicated to Tribhuvanamaheśvara (the Lord of the Three Worlds). After that, you will continue on to Banteay Samre, of elaborate architecture and exceptional carvings. On your way back, you will pass by Srah Srang (ablution pool), where you will contemplate the sunset.

Lunch on your own and overnight at the hotel in Siem Reap.

Day 14 : Siem Reap - Angkor Thom - Angkor Wat - Ta Prohm (B, L)

Breakfast at the hotel, you will enjoy a beautiful and incredibly rewarding day of exploration. First, you will visit the Angkor Thom temple complex, which was built by Khmer King Jayavarman VII in the late 12th and early 13th century. This complex includes the South Gate, Bayon, Baphuon, Elephant Terrace, Phimeanakas, Old Royal Palace and Terrace of the Leper King. Angkor Thom, whose name means "great city", witnessed the greatness of the Empire.

In the afternoon, you will visit the largest and most beautiful temple of the monumental complex of Angkor Wat, built by Suryavarman II in the early 12th century. This place is the city of monasteries, the spiritual center and identity of the Khmer people in the South. The temple is imbued with a unique, natural, complex and symbolic Khmer architecture. It is also one of the most impressive architectural masterpieces still preserved in the world.

You will then head to Ta Prohm, an abandoned Buddhist temple dating from the 12th century and considered a symbol of the power of nature.

In the evening, you will enjoy an Apsara dance show while dining at a local restaurant.

Lunch on your own, dinner included and hotel accommodation in Siem Reap.

Day 15: Siem Reap → Bangkok (B)

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Siem Reap International Airport for flight to Bangkok.

Upon arrival in Bangkok, you will be met by our driver and guide, then transferred by private transport to check in at the hotel.

Day 16: Bangkok - Discovery (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, departure to the most important place of worship in Thailand, the Grand Palace, built in 1782 by order of King Rama I. In the complex are the king's workplace, government offices, the harem, etc.. The highlight of the complex is Wat Phra Kaew, also known as the Temple of the Emerald Buddha.



The next stop is Wat Pho, also known as the Temple of the Reclining Buddha. The reclining Buddha, which is about 46 meters long, is one of the largest reclining Buddha in the world. Next, you will visit Wat Traimit, also known as the Golden Buddha, a wonderful Buddha statue weighing 5.5 tons located in the China Town area.

You will take a boat ride for an excursion along the Chao Phraya River and nearby canals (also known as Khlong in Thai language) to see the bustling hinterland offering fantastic views of local life around the Bangkok waterway and its sub-districts.

At the end, you will visit Wat Arun, whose name means Temple of Dawn. It is one of the most famous temples on the western bank of the Chao Phraya River. This temple is famous because of the beauty and charm characteristic of its decoration.

Meals on your own and hotel accommodation in Bangkok.

Day 17: Bangkok - Railway market - Floating market (B)

Breakfast at the hotel.

07h00: Departure to the Maeklong railway market. This market is called in Thai Talat Rom Hup, which means "market of unfolding umbrellas". Every time a train approaches, the awnings and store fronts are pulled away from the rails, only to be put up again once the train has passed.

You will continue to visit the Damnoen Saduak floating market. You will board a private boat and cruise along some of the canals on your way to the market and get a glimpse of authentic life along the canals.



Return to the center of Bangkok.
