At the beginning of the tour, you will head to Punta Bandera pier to take a catamaran trip on the Argentino Lake. First you will visit the northern part of the lake where you can observe the amazing icebergs floating adrift, and then you will see the fantastic Upsala Glacier where you will meet a spectacular Ice Barrier whose area of 800 square kilometers is equal to 4 times the City of Buenos Aires! After you pass the front wall of this glacier, the ride continues to see the highest Glacier in the National Park, the Spegazzini glacier where you also can observe the Seco glacier and finally you will return through the Boca de diablo (Devil's mouth) which is the narrowest part of the lake . After this awesome boat trip you will never forget El Calafate town and the Patagonia region. Fortunately, your films and photos will always remind you that it wasn't a dream and that you certainly were there. Note: The tour can be modified depending on weather conditions and decision of the captain of the vessel.

Explore Antarctica: An Unforgettable Voyage with Landings



1st Day Buenos Aires

Morning arrival at the Buenos Aires Airport in Argentina. During the transfer to your hotel, an orientation tour of the city will be given. You have the rest of the day to explore at leisure, or join one of the optional excursions.

2nd Day Buenos Aires-Ushuaia

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Ushuaia, the world's southernmost city. Once you land in Ushuaia, a tourist guide from 01argentina will be waiting for you with a sign with your last name to transfer you to your Hotel in Ushuaia.

3rd Day Depart from Ushuaia Port.

(Embarkation) Embark the USHUAIA ship in the afternoon and meet your expedition and lecture staff. After you have settled into your cabins we sail along the famous Beagle Channel and the scenic Mackinlay Pass.



3 & 4th Day Crossing the Drake Passage

Named after the renowned explorer, Sir Frances Drake, who sailed these waters in 1578, the Drake Passage also marks the Antarctic Convergence, a biological barrier where cold polar water sinks beneath the warmer northern waters. This creates a great upwelling of nutrients, which sustains the biodiversity of this region. The Drake Passage also marks the northern limit of many Antarctic seabirds. As we sail across the passage, Antarpply Expeditions' lecturers will be out with you on deck to help in the identification of an amazing variety of seabirds, including many albatrosses, which follow in our wake. The USHUAIA's open bridge policy allows you to join our officers on the bridge and learn about navigation, watch for whales, and enjoy the view. A full program of lectures will be offered as well.

The first sightings of icebergs and snow-capped mountains indicate that we have reached the South Shetland Islands, a group of twenty islands and islets first sighted in February 1819 by Capt. William Smith of the brig Williams. With favorable conditions in the Drake Passage our lecturers and naturalists will accompany you ashore as you experience your first encounter with the penguins and seals on Day 3.





5 to 9th Days Exploring South Shetland Islands and the Antarctic Peninsula

The South Shetland Islands are a haven for wildlife. Vast penguin rookeries, beaches ruled by Antarctic fur seals and southern elephant seals make every day spent in this amazing island group unforgettable. Sailing through the narrow passage into the flooded caldera of Deception Island and the chance to swim in the hot springs of Pendulum Cove is truly amazing. King

George Island, the largest of the South Shetland Islands, features colonies of nesting Adélie and Chinstrap Penguins, Kelp Gulls, Blue-eyed Cormorants, Antarctic Terns and Southern Giant Petrels and is home to scientific bases of many different countries. Macaroni, Chinstrap and Gentoo Penguins as well as elephant seals await you at Livingston Island.

The Antarctic Peninsula's remarkable history will provide you with a type of excitement often only associated with the early explorers. You will have plenty of time to explore its amazing scenery, a pristine wilderness of snow, ice, mountains and waterways, and an incredible wide variety of wildlife. Apart from penguins and seabirds you are very likely to see Weddell, crabeater and leopard seals as well as Minke, killer (orca) and humpback whales at close range. We hope to navigate some of the most beautiful waterways (depending on the ice conditions): the Gerlache Strait, the Neumayer Channel, and the Lemaire Channel, the latter are narrow passages between towering rock faces and spectacular glaciers. We plan to make at least two landings per day.



Possible landing sites may include

Paradise Bay is perhaps the most aptly named place in the world and we attempt a landing on the continent proper. After negotiating the iceberg-strewn waters of the Antarctic Sound, we hope to visit the bustling Adélie Penguin (over 100,000 pairs breed here) and Blue-eyed Cormorant colonies on Paulet Island. The Nordenskjöld expedition built a stone survival hut here in 1903. Today its ruins have been taken over by nesting penguins.

Further exploration may take you to Melchior Island, Cuverville Island, Portal Point, Neko Harbour, Pléneau Island and if ice conditions permit, to Petermann Island for a visit to the southernmost colony of Gentoo Penguins.





10 & 11th Days

At Sea crossing the Drake Passage, northbound. We leave Antarctica and head north across the Drake Passage. Join our lecturers and naturalists on deck as we search for seabirds and whales and enjoy some final lectures. Take the chance to relax and reflect on the fascinating adventures of the past days on the way back to Ushuaia.





12th Day Disembarkation-Ushuaia

In the morning, you will reach the Argentinean city of Ushuaia. Ushuaia is reckoned to be the most southerly city in the world and is situated on Tierra del Fuego Island south of the Magellan Strait. The rest of the day is at your disposal. [Day 13: Ushuaia - Buenos Aires: Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Return to Buenos Aires. You have the rest of the day to explore at leisure, or join one of the optional excursions.





14th Day Return to your home country

shore. During the tour, you will observe a lot of flora formed by the massive trees as well as a great variety of birds native to these woods.

After the trek, you will board very stable Canoes and sail to the Beagle Channel. You will go up to Isla de Lobos and Isla Redonda while viewing the Imperial Cormorants. Continuing your tour, you will disembark on the island to have a coffee break in a refuge where the native Yamaná Indian people used to live, while enjoying a spectacular view of the Beagle Channel. After the break, you will have some time to rest and in the early afternoon we will continue riding until you reach Lapataia Bay to see marine birds. 





Then visit the topknot-quarry Puna Pau with its red scoria stone, where all the Pukaos were made. Back to hotel. If passengers did not book Citytur, we also visit the ceremonial site of Tahai with 3 Ahus and restored statues, remains of boathouses, a boatramp and other features. Here we see the only statue with eyes re-inserted



Day 19 Full day (Duration 7 hours)

During our full day tour we will drive to the southcoast coast and visit representative examples of not restored platform, Ahus Vaihu in the bay of Hanga Te'e, where we also visit the reconstruction of a former village. Then we visit Akahanga, where supposedly the famous king Hotu Matua was buried. Proceed to Rano Raraku, quarry of almost 900 stone statues, 397 of them still lying or standing at the slopes of the extinct volcano with crater lake. Then visit Ahu Tongariki (restored with 15 Moais), most recent and biggest restauration on the island. For lunch we stop at a little restaurant with view at Rano Raraku. Afterwards drive to the eastcoast and visit Ahu Te Pito Kura and the "Navel of the World". Last but not least visit the beach of Anakena with its restored Ahus Nau Nau and Ature Huke. There you will have the opportunity to enjoy the warm Pacific Ocean before returning back to the hotel.

Day 20 Half day Orongo (Duration 3 hrs)

We will visit the extinct volcano Rano Kau, appreciate on the way a view over the whole island and see its distinct geological features, proceed to an outlook at the crater

lake. Afterwards drive to the ceremonial village of Orongo, where the birdman competition took place and you can see the spectacular petroglyphs related to this culture, enjoy the breathtaking view towards the 3 islets Motu Nui, Motu Iti and Motu Kao Kao opposite the coast. Drive down again to Ahu Vinapu (not restored) and for some still proof of the influence of pre-inca arquitects in Easter Island culture. Last stop is the fishermen's harbour Hanga Piko, where we visit the restored Ahu Riata. Back to hotel.



Day 21 Half day - Tahai, City Tour, and Musuem (Duration 3 hrs)

We will visit the ceremonial site of Tahai with 3 Ahus and restored statues, remains of boathouses, a boatramp and other features. Here we see the only statue with eyes re-inserted. In the nearby museum, we will have an overview over the Geology, Geography and the History of Rapa Nui and its people. At the end of the tour, we will pass through the village of HANGA ROA, and visit the church and the artisan market.



Day 22 Traditional "Umu" dinner with typical dance and music show

Umu, or "curanto", is a traditional Rapa Nui way of cooking that is frequently made as an offering, to request the blessing of the ancestors for a holiday or special event, or to ask for well-being. Chicken and fish are the most common meats, because they were part of the diet of the ancient Rapa Nui. Along with this, vegetables such as sweet potato or taro, among others, are cooked over hot coals and stones covered with banana leaves. The dinner is accompanied by a typical dance and music show highlighting the ancient Rapa Nui culture.
